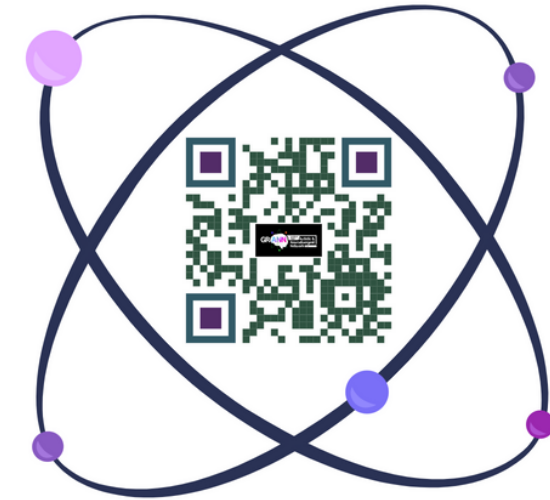

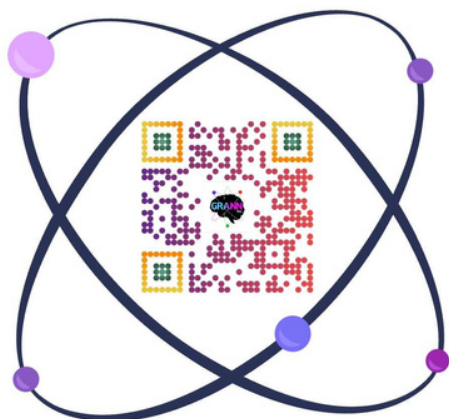
Gain access to local workshops, grant opportunities, and volunteer positions designed to enhance your passions, interests and empower you.
